

Summary of the University Committee for Research and Innovation meeting (UCRI) held on 12 July 2022

At this meeting:

- We reviewed the established RETF funding for Open Access, with funds for journals as well as Open
 Access monographs. This fund allows for authors who do not have UKRI funding (there is a separate
 UKRI block grant) to publish research as Gold Open Access. Following a discussion we agreed that there
 was a short term need to identify ways to reduce costs and in the longer term work needs to be done
 within the Planning and Strategy Board to accommodate open access costs within the library budget.
