openly accessible wherever possible, or accessible to the fullest extent compatible with any legal, ethical or commercial restrictions. If the student is in receipt of funding from a public or charitable funder, such as a Research Council or the Wellcome Trust, they will be subject to <u>similar requirements from their funder</u> as well.

The purpose of the DMP is for the student to document how they will manage their data

The student may not be able to complete all relevant sections of the DMP in the version submitted for the first annual review. This is quite acceptable, but the student should demonstrate that data management requirements have been considered and put in place markers for future development of the plan.

What to look for

When assessing a DMP, you should look for the following qualities:
